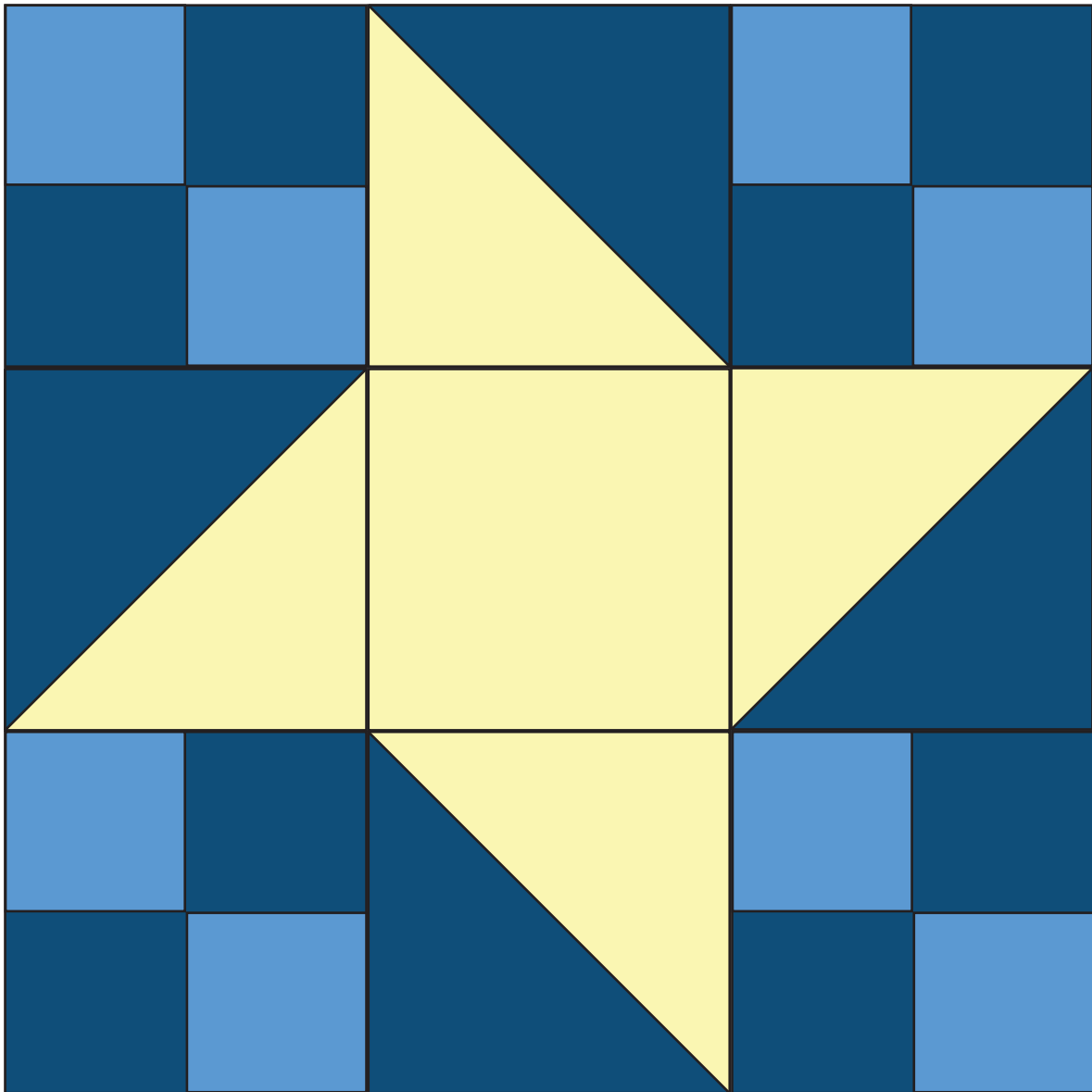


# Sadie's Star Block

## Vintage Block #8

# Sadie's Star Block

Block Size: 9" Finished

## Materials needed for one block:

Dark Fabric:

- 1 fat quarter or 10" x 18" scrap

Medium Fabric:

- 1 fat quarter or 6" x 10" scrap

Light Fabric:

- 1 fat quarter or 10" x 14" scrap

## Cutting Instructions:

From the dark fabric, cut:

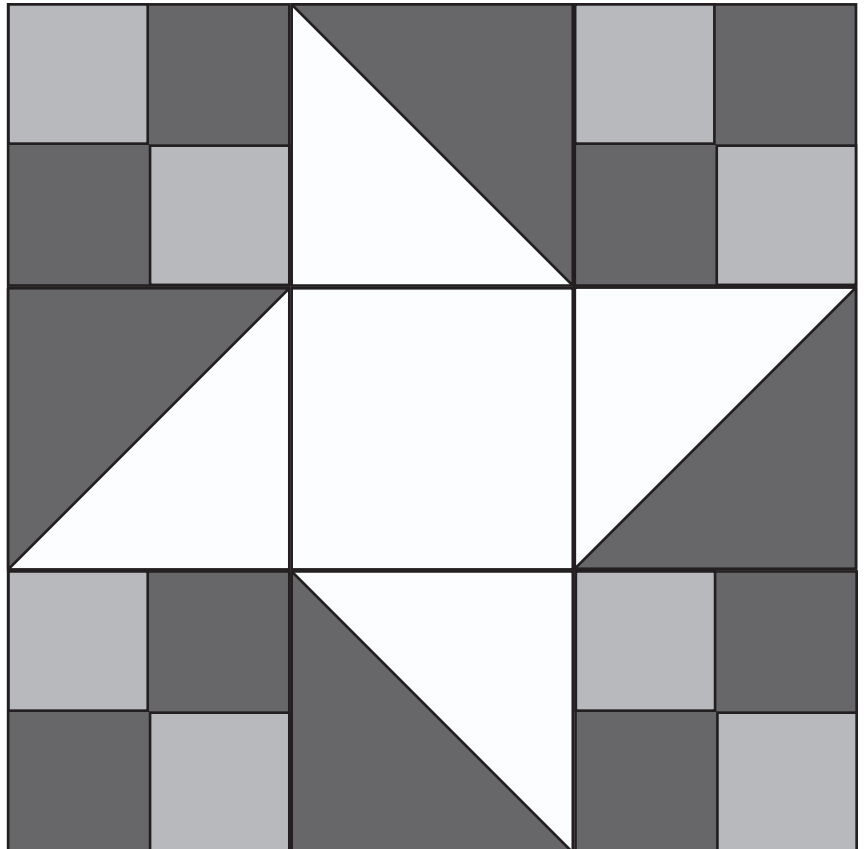
- 8 – 2" x 2" squares
- 2 – 4" x 4" squares

From the medium fabric, cut:

- 8 – 2" x 2" squares

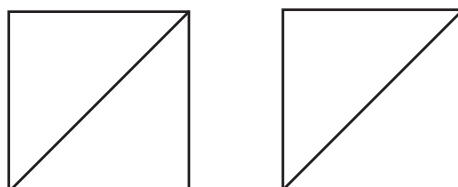
From the light fabric, cut:

- 2 – 4" x 4" squares
- 1 – 3½" x 3½" square

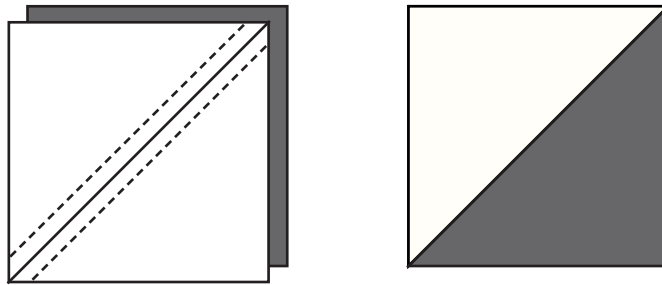


## Assembling the block:

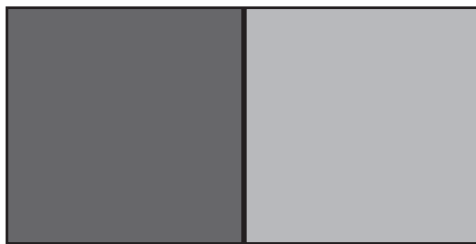
1. On the back of a 4" x 4" light square, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown below. Measuring a quarter inch from the drawn line, draw the sewing lines on each side. Make two.



2. Place a 4" x 4" light square on a 4" x 4" dark square, right sides together, and sew on the outer lines as shown below. Cut apart on the center line. Size to 3½" x 3½". Repeat for the other marked light squares. Make 4 half-square triangles.



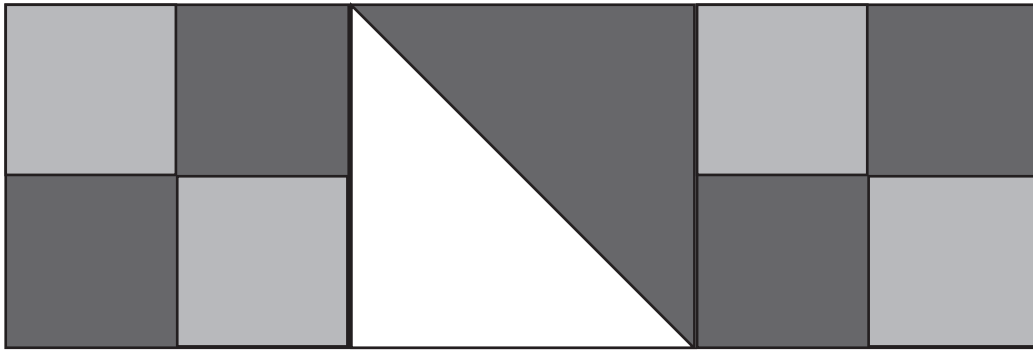
3. Sew a 2" x 2" dark square to a 2" x 2" medium square as shown below. Press the seams toward the dark square. Repeat for the other seven dark and medium 2" x 2" squares. Make eight units.



4. Sew two units made in step three together as shown below. Make 4 four-patch units.



5. Sew a four-patch unit made in step four to each side of a half-square triangle made in step two as shown below. Make two.



6. Sew a half-square triangle made in step two to each side of the  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " light square. Press the seams toward the center square.



7. Assemble the rows according to the diagram below:
