

Grand Rapids Block

10" x 10" finished block size

10½" x 60½" unfinished row size

Fabric Requirements:

*If traveling to the show, pick up your favorite fabrics to put in that row!

White: ½ yard

Orange: ⅓ yard

Magenta: ½ yard

Cutting Instructions:

From the white fabric, cut:

24 – 2½" x 2½" squares

24 – 3" x 3" squares

1 - 2½" strips from the width of fabric

1 – 2½" x 20" strip

From the orange fabric, cut:

8 – 2½" x 2½" orange squares

8 – 3" x 3" orange squares

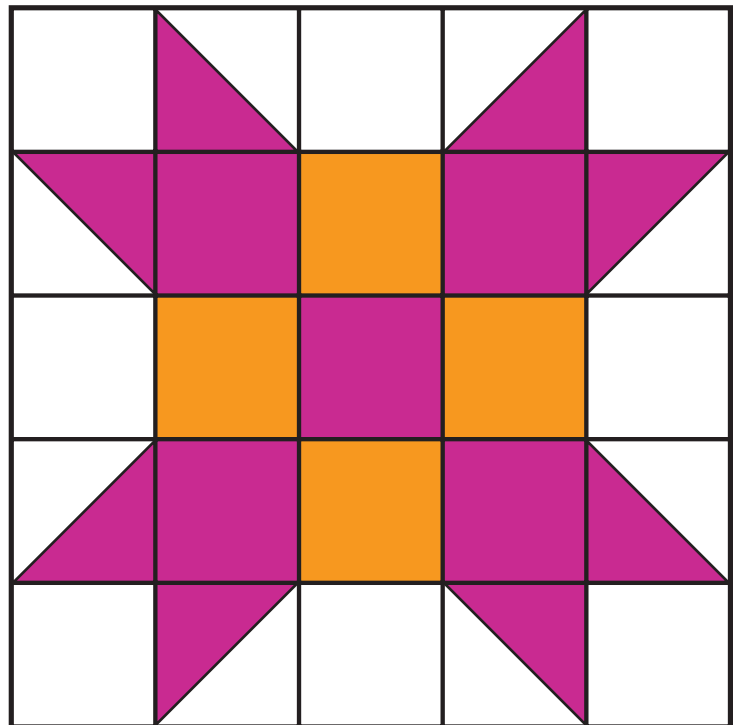
1 – 2½" strip from the width of fabric

From the magenta fabric, cut:

22 – 2½" x 2½" magenta squares

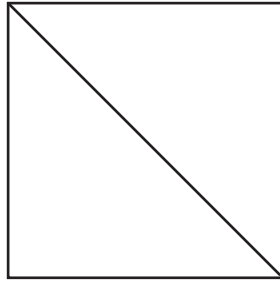
16 – 3" x 3" squares

1- 2½" x 20" strip

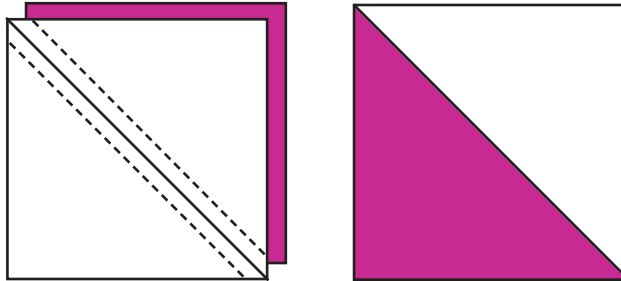


Block Assembly Instructions:

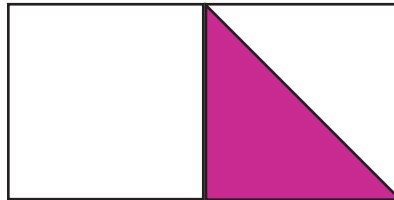
1. Draw a diagonal line once from corner to corner on the wrong side of 16 white 3" squares.



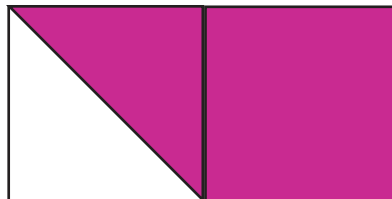
2. With right sides together, layer a marked 3" white square on top of a 3" magenta square. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both sides of the line, then cut apart on the drawn line. Press seams toward the purple side. Size the squares to $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat with the remaining 3" magenta squares.



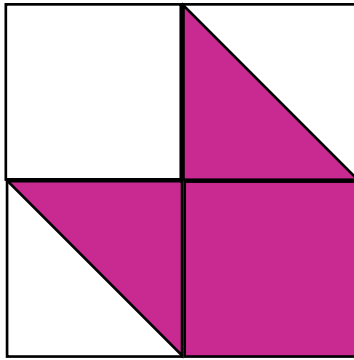
3. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " white square to a unit made in step two as shown below.



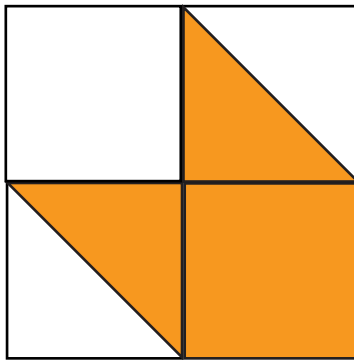
4. Sew a unit made in step two to a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " magenta square as shown below.



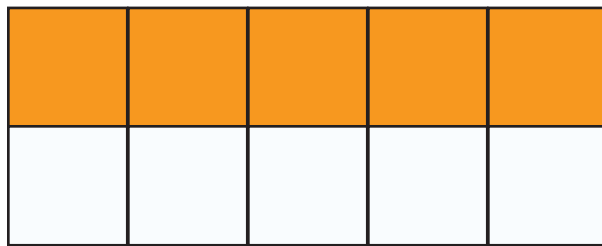
5. Repeat steps three and four to make 16 magenta star point units.



6. Repeat steps one to four to make 8 orange star point units.



7. Sew the 2½" orange strip to the 2½" white strip. Cut into 2½" segments as shown below. Make 16 segments.



8. Repeat step seven using the 2½" x 20" magenta strip and the 2½" x 20" white strip. Make 8 segments.
