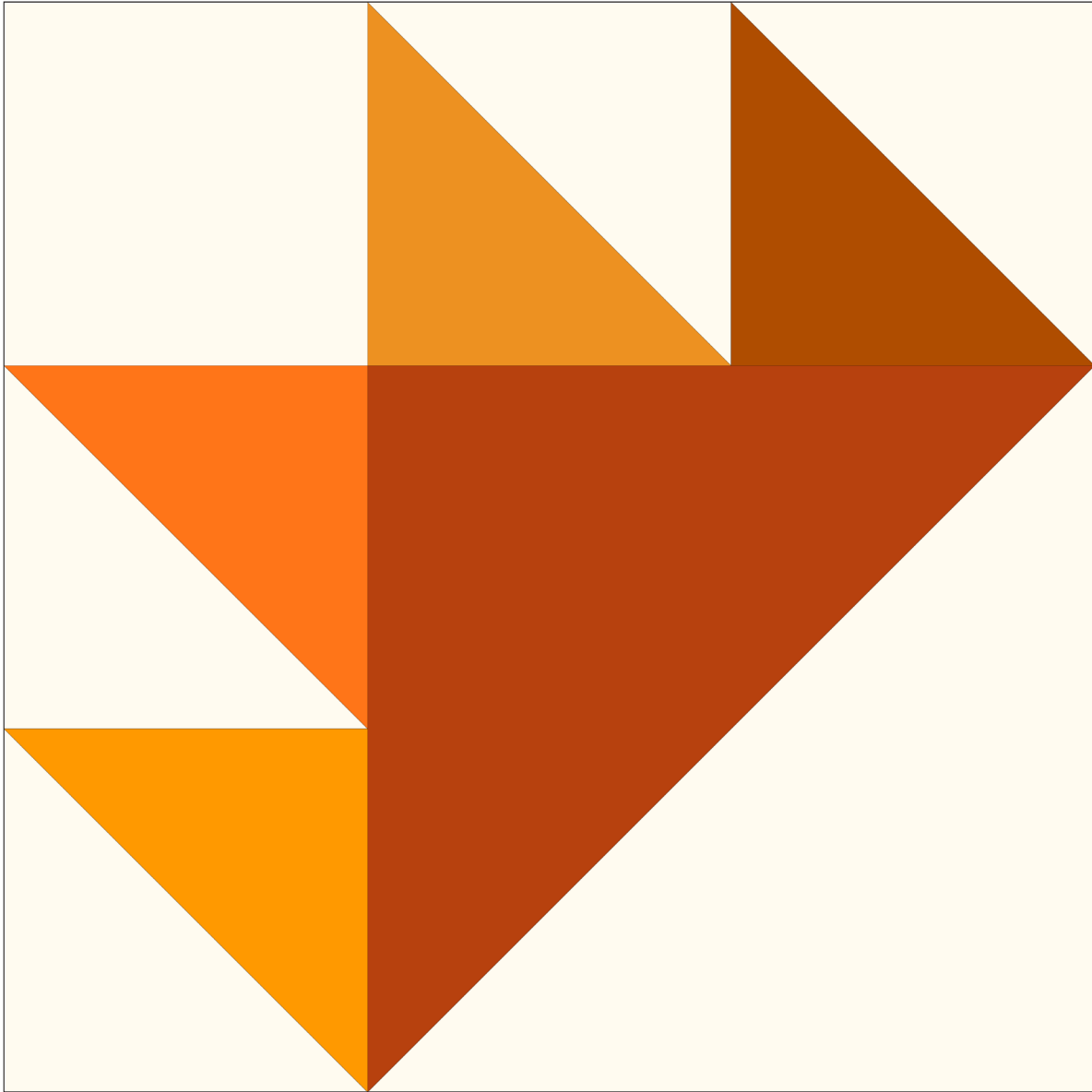


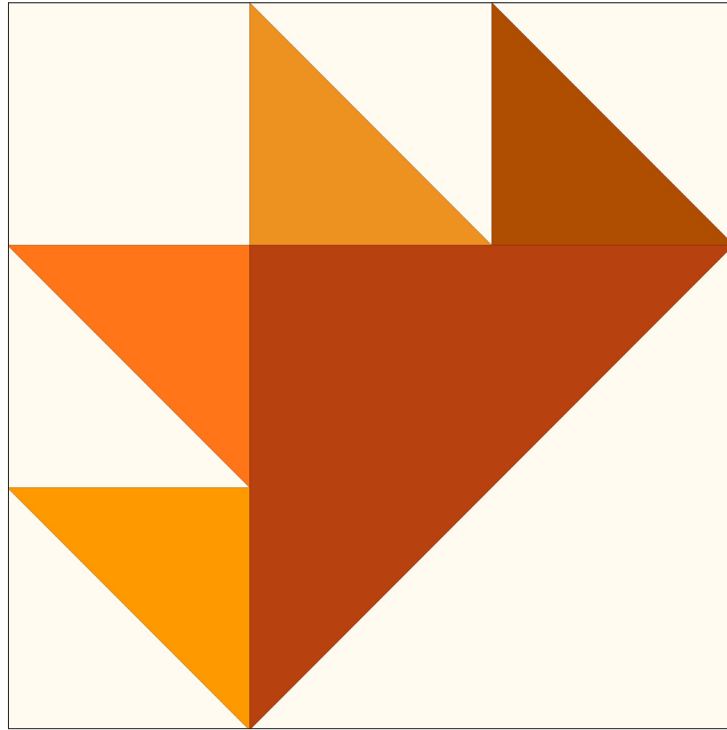
# Leaf Pile

# Leaf Pile

72" x 72"



Leaf - 18" Finished Block Size

## Fabric Requirements

Leaf Points - four scraps of at least 7"

Leaf Body - one scrap of at least 13"

Background -  $\frac{5}{8}$  yard

## Cutting Instructions

Leaf Points -

4 - 7" squares

Leaf Body -

1 - 13" square

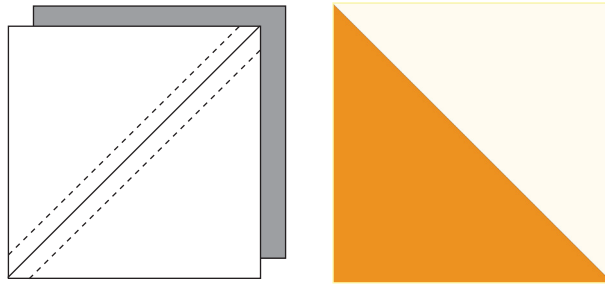
Background -

4 - 7" squares

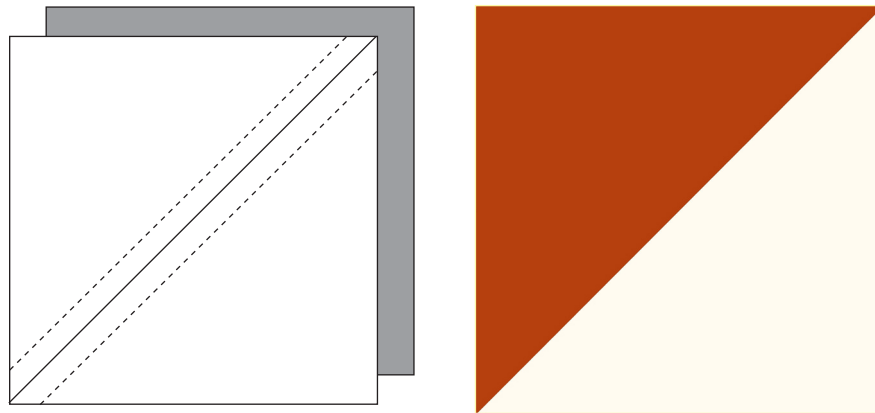
1 - 13" square

## Assembly Construction

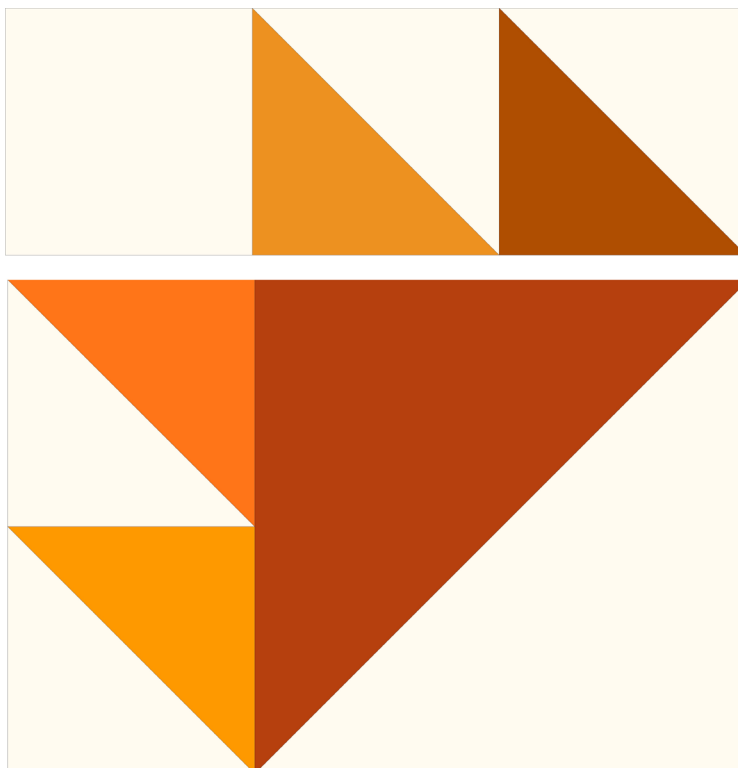
1. Using the leaf point squares and background squares, make half square triangles. Size to  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

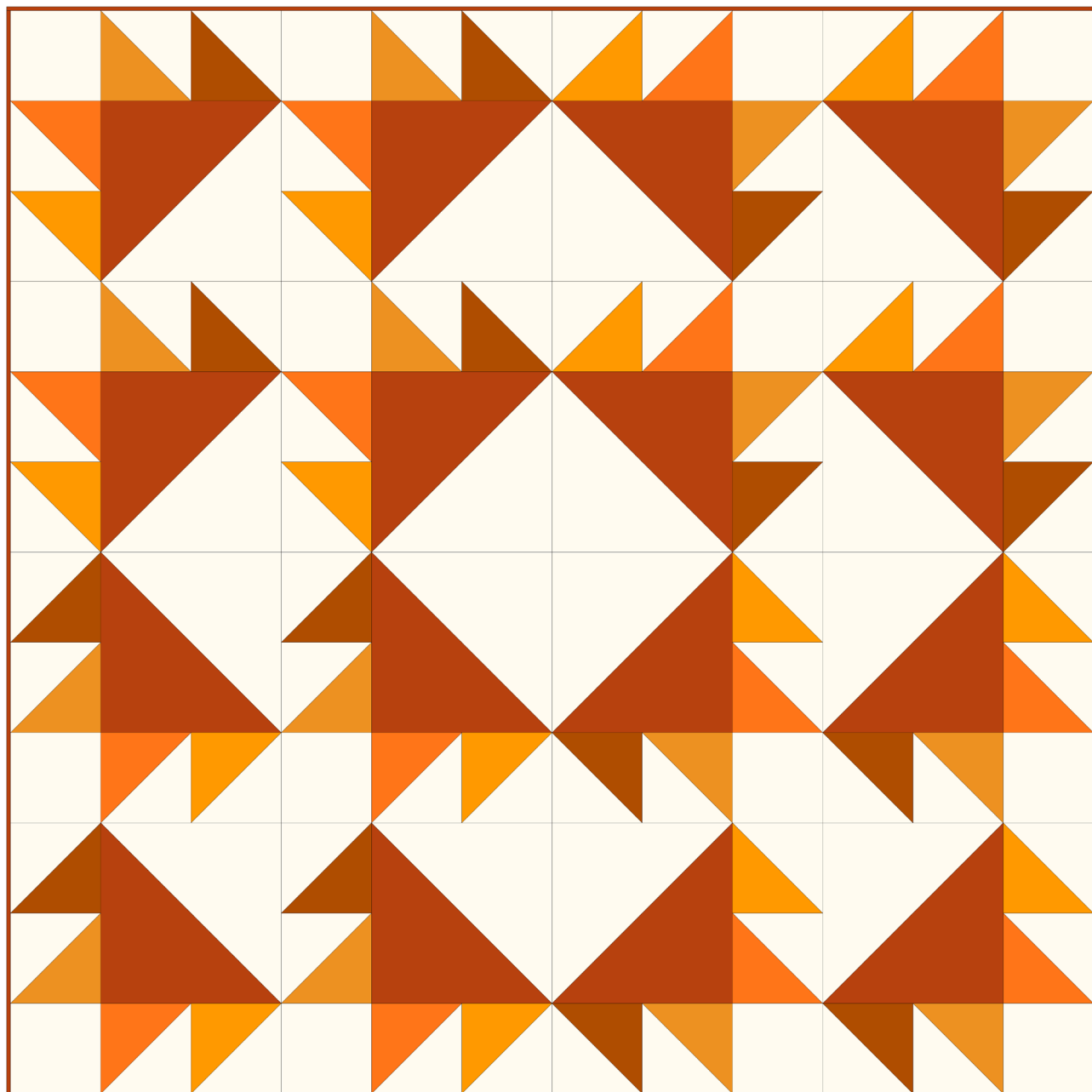


2. Using the leaf body square and the background square, make a half square triangle. Size to  $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".



3. Sew the Leaf block together.





4. Make sure the blocks are sized to 18½" and lay them out in rows.
5. Turn them the direction shown or something completely different!
6. Sew the blocks into rows and rows into the quilt.
