## BLOCK 15

### CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

- (1)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{3}{8}$ "
- (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the coral fabric, cut:

- (2) 3" x 3"
- (4)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the yellow fabric, cut:

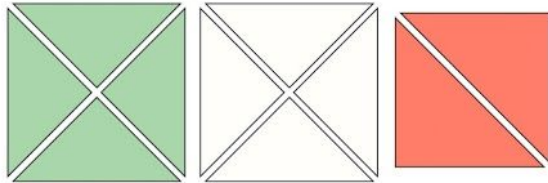
- (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the green fabric, cut:

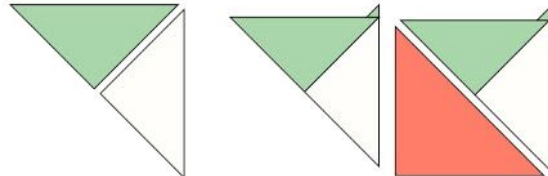
- (1)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{3}{8}$ "

### SPLIT QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE (SPLIT QST) UNITS

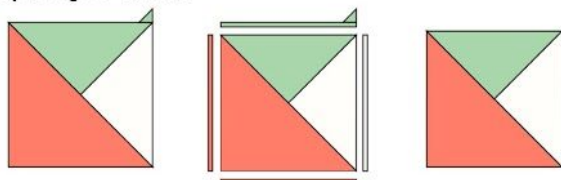
Cut a green and a white  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " square in half diagonally twice. Cut two coral 3" squares in half once.



Sew a green and a white quarter square triangle together as shown below and press. Then sew a coral half square triangle to the pair.

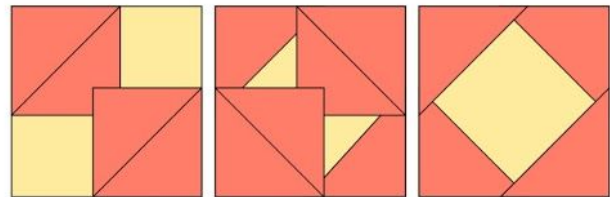


Trim the Split QST evenly to  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make 4 Split QST units.



### SQUARE IN A SQUARE (SIAS) UNIT

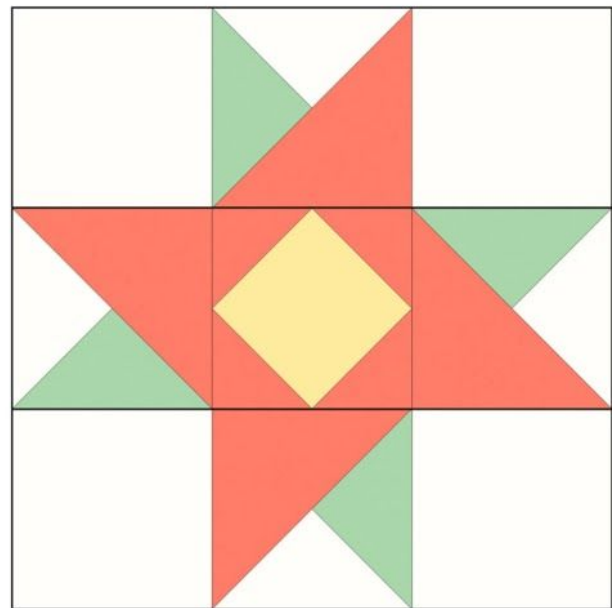
Mark the wrong side of 4 coral  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over the corner of a yellow  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and press.



Repeat on the remaining corners with the marked squares to make an SIAS unit. Make 1.

### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
