

BLOCK 18

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut: $(4) 2'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ "


From the coral fabric, cut: (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the yellow fabric, cut: (2) 2½" x 2½"

From the green fabric, cut: (4) 2" x 2"

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS


Mark the wrong side of the coral $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a yellow $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 2" square.



Make 4 coral/yellow HST.

QUARTER SECTION UNITS


Arrange a green 2" square, a coral/yellow HST, and a white 2" x 3½" rectangle as shown below. Sew the green square and HST together and press. Then sew the white rectangle to the left side.



Quarter Section unit measures $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
