BLOCK 19

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:
(4) 2½" x 2½"

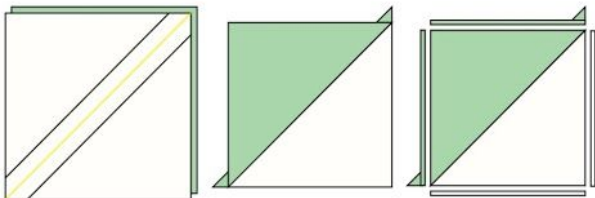
From the coral fabric, cut:
(2) 2½" x 2½"

From the yellow fabric, cut:
(4) 2" x 3½"

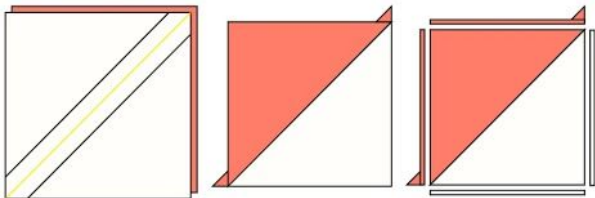
From the green fabric, cut:
(2) 2½" x 2½"

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the white 2½" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a green 2½" square, right sides together. Sew a ¼" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 2" square. Make 4 white/green HST.

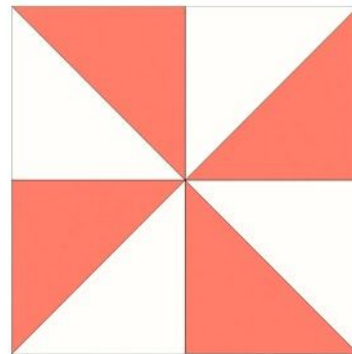


Repeat to make 4 white/coral HST.



PINWHEEL UNIT

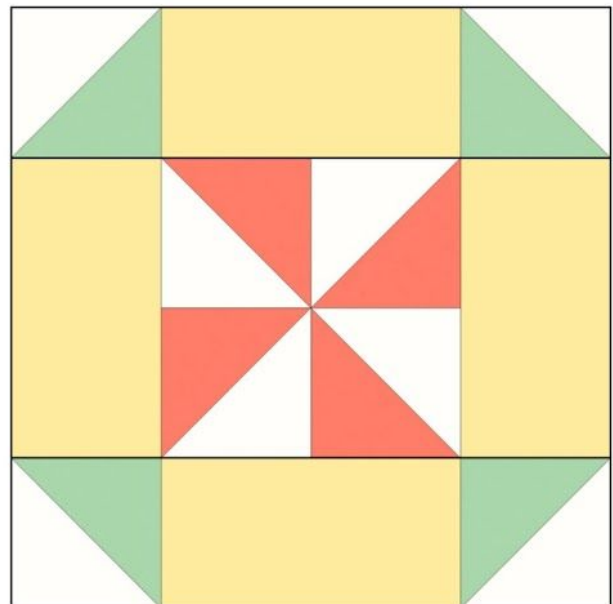
Arrange the 4 white/coral HST into a Pinwheel as shown below. Sew together in pairs and press, then sew the pairs together.



Pinwheel unit measures 3½" x 3½" unfinished.
Make 1.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.
