## BLOCK 30

### CUTTING

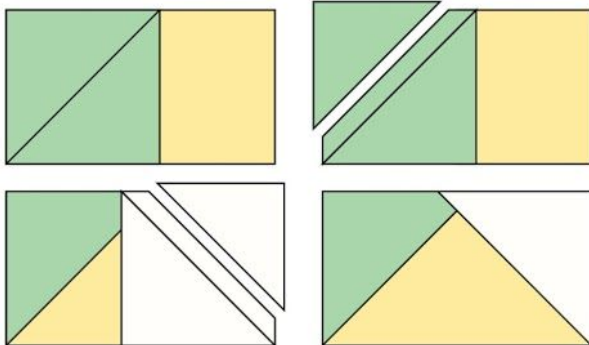
From the white fabric, cut:  
(8) 2" x 2"

From the yellow fabric, cut:  
(4) 2" x 3½"  
(4) 2" x 2"

From the green fabric, cut:  
(4) 2" x 2"

### FLYING GEESSE UNITS

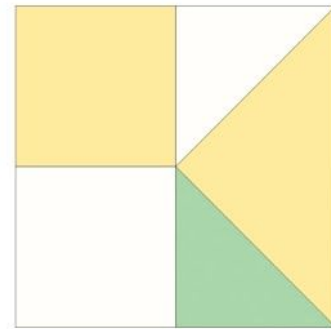
Mark the wrong side of a green 2" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a yellow 2" x 3½" rectangle, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another marked white 2" square.



Make 4 yellow/green/white Flying Geese units.

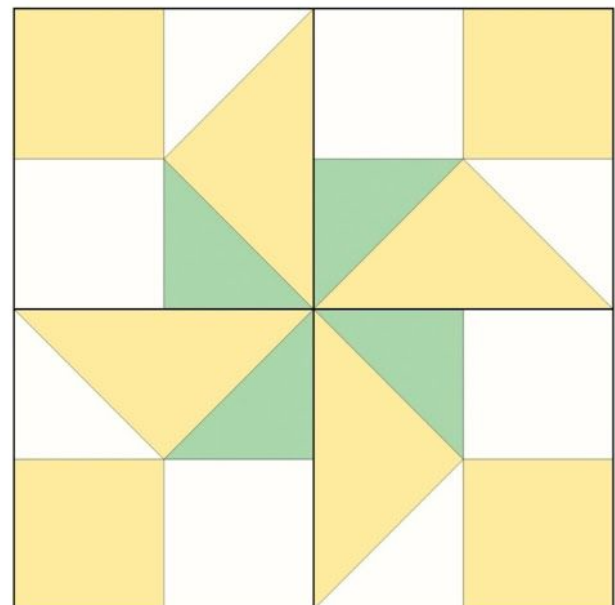
### QUARTER SECTION UNITS

Arrange a yellow and a white 2" square, and a Flying Geese unit as shown below. Sew the squares together and press. Sew the Flying Geese unit to the pair. Quarter Section unit measures 3½" x 3½" unfinished. Make 4.



### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.
