BLOCK 36

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut: $(4) 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the coral fabric, cut:

- (4) 11/2" x 21/2"
- (4) 11/2" x 11/2"

From the yellow fabric, cut:


- (1) 21/2" x 21/2"
- (4) 11/2" x 11/2"

From the green fabric, cut:

(4) 11/2" x 21/2"


RAIL UNITS

Arrange a green and a white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle as shown below. Sew together on the long side. Rail unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.




CORNER UNITS

Arrange a coral and a yellow $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square, and a coral $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle as shown below. Sew the squares together in pairs and press. Then sew the rectangle to the pairs. Corner unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
