BLOCK 6

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:
(8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2"

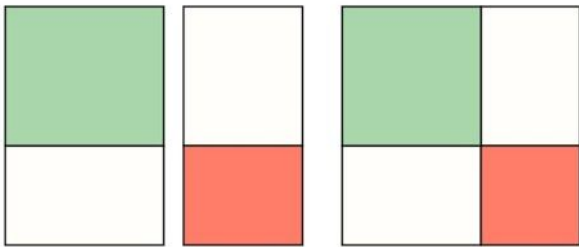
From the coral fabric, cut:
(4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3"
(4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the yellow fabric, cut:
(1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the green fabric, cut:
(4) 2" x 2"

UNEVEN FOUR PATCH UNITS

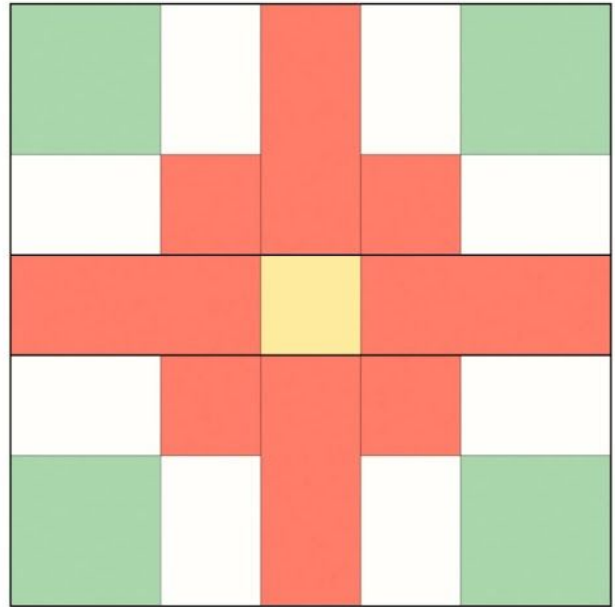
Arrange a green 2" square, a coral $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square, and two white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangles as shown below. Sew together in pairs and press. Then sew the pairs together.



Uneven Four Patch unit measures
3" x 3" unfinished. Make 4.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out.
Sew all the pieces into rows.
Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
