BLOCK 7

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:
(4) 2" x 2"

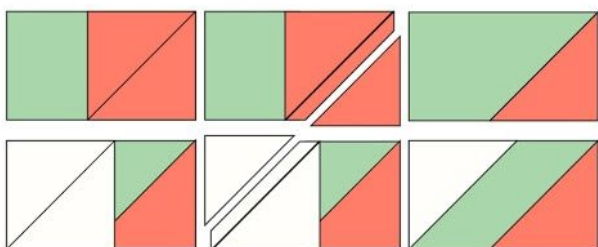
From the coral fabric, cut:
(8) 2" x 2"

From the yellow fabric, cut:
(4) 2" x 3½"

From the green fabric, cut:
(4) 2" x 3½"

CORNER FLIP UNITS

Mark the wrong side of a white 2" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a green 2" x 3½" rectangle on the left end, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the opposite corner with a coral 2" square.



Make 4 green/white/coral Corner Flip units.

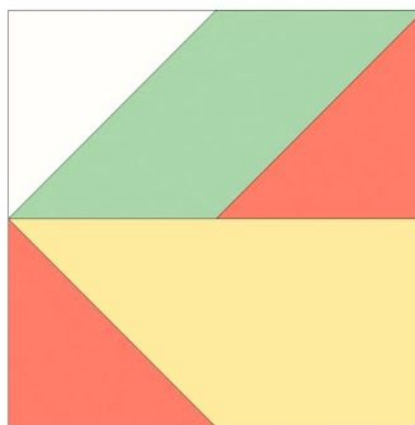
Mark the wrong side of a coral 2" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a yellow 3" x 3½" rectangle on the left end, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press.



Make 4 yellow/coral Corner Flip units.

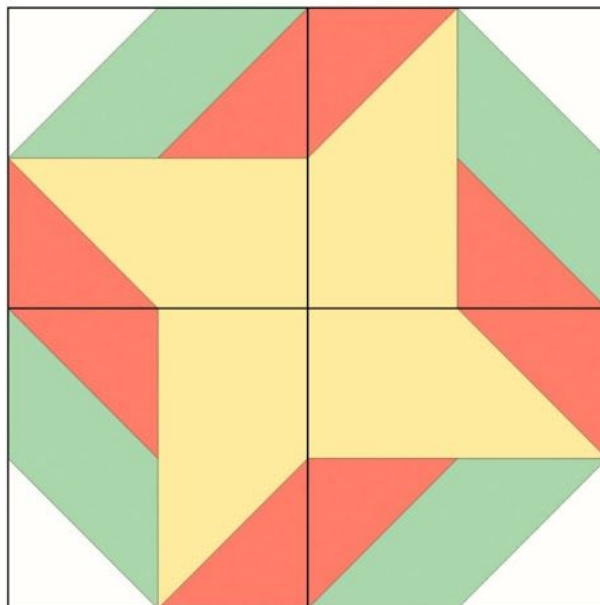
QUARTER SECTION UNITS

Arrange one of each of the Corner Flip units as shown below and sew together. Quarter Section unit measures 3½" x 3½" unfinished. Make 4.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.
