BLOCK 33

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

(2) 2" x 3½"

(8) 2" x 2"

From the coral fabric, cut:

(4) 2" x 3½"

(4) 2" x 2"

From the yellow fabric, cut:

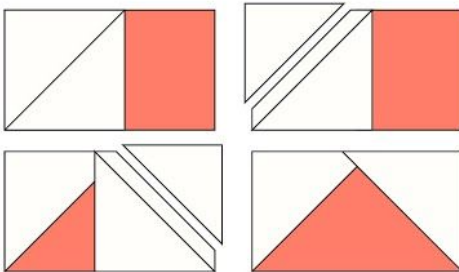
(4) 2" x 2"

From the green fabric, cut:

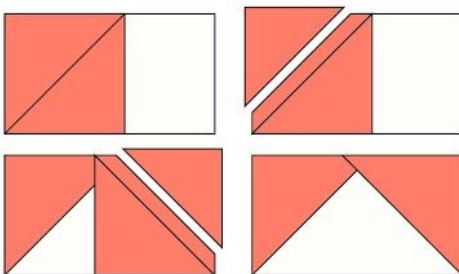
(1) 3½" x 3½"

FLYING GEESE UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the white 2" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square right sides together with a coral 2" x 3½" rectangle, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another marked white 2" square.

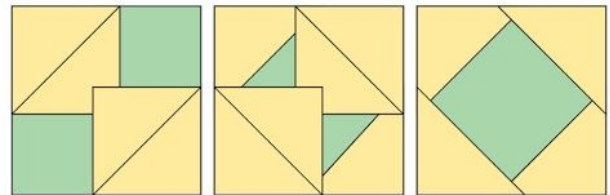


Make 4 coral/white Flying Geese units.
Repeat to make 2 white/coral Flying Geese units.



SQUARE IN A SQUARE UNIT

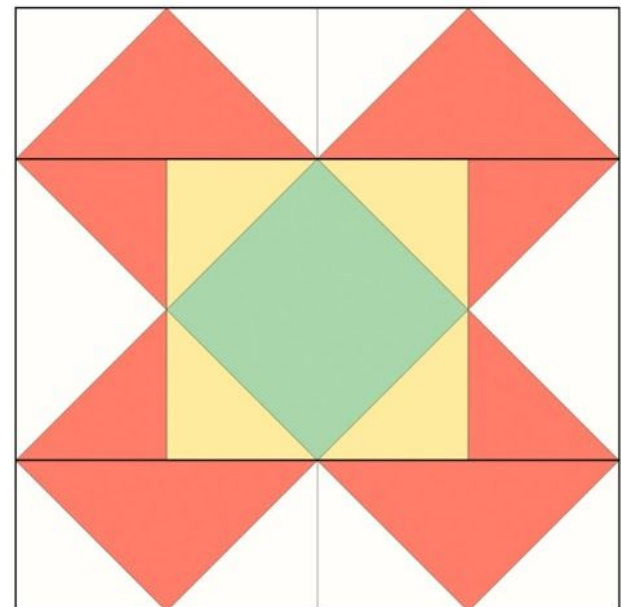
Mark the wrong side of 4 yellow 2" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over the corner of a green 3½" square, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the remaining corners with the marked squares to make an SIAS unit.



Make 1.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.
