## BLOCK 27

### CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

(5)  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

(8)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$

From the coral fabric, cut:

(4)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$

From the yellow fabric, cut:

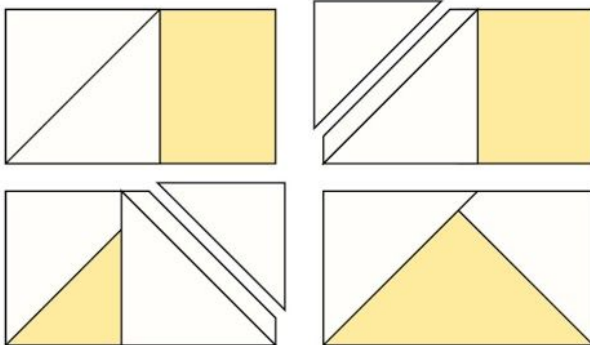
(4)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

From the green fabric, cut:

(4)  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$

### FLYING GEESE UNITS

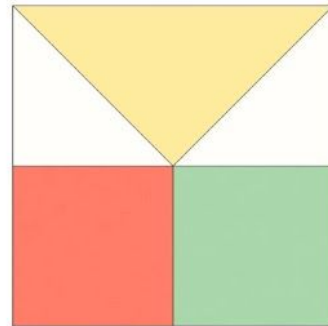
Mark the wrong side of a white  $1\frac{1}{2}''$  square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square right sides together with a yellow  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangle, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a  $\frac{1}{4}''$  seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another marked white  $1\frac{1}{2}''$  square.



Make 4 yellow/white Flying Geese units.

### STAR POINT UNITS

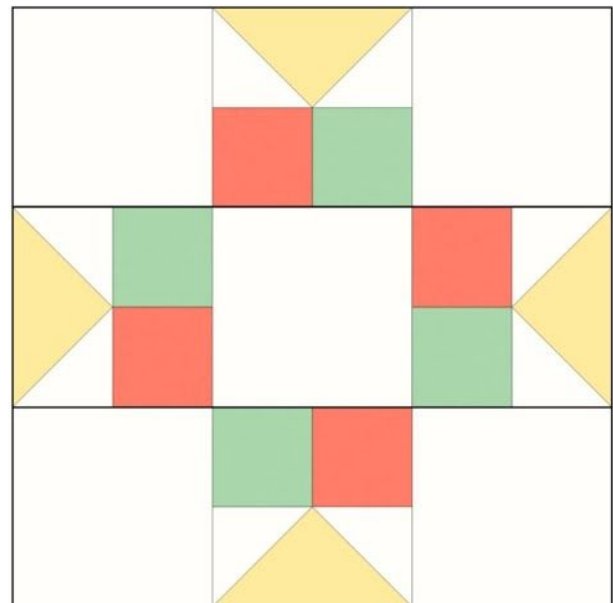
Arrange a coral and a green  $1\frac{1}{2}''$  square, and a yellow/white Flying Geese unit as shown below. Sew the coral and green squares together and press. Then sew the yellow/white Flying Geese unit on top.



Star Point unit measures  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$  unfinished. Make 4.

### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures  $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  unfinished.
