BLOCK 28

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

(2) 2½" x 2½"

(4) 2" x 2"

From the coral fabric, cut:

(2) 2" x 2"

From the yellow fabric, cut:

(2) 2" x 2"

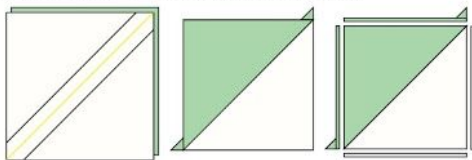
From the green fabric, cut:

(2) 2½" x 2½"

(4) 2" x 3½"

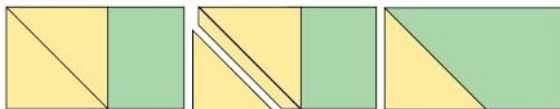
HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the white 2½" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a green 2½" square, right sides together. Sew a ¼" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 2" square. Make 4 white/green HST.



CORNER FLIP UNITS

Mark the wrong side of a yellow 2" square diagonally. Lay the marked square over a green 2" x 3½" rectangle, oriented as shown below. Sew on marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press.



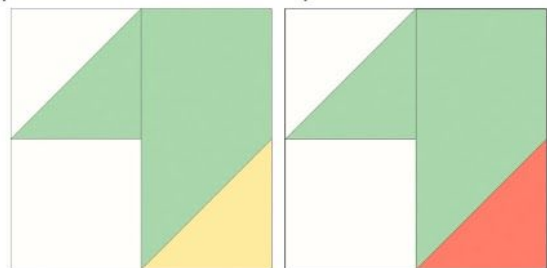
Make 2 green/yellow Corner Flip units.

Repeat to make 2 green/coral Corner Flip units.



QUARTER SECTION UNITS

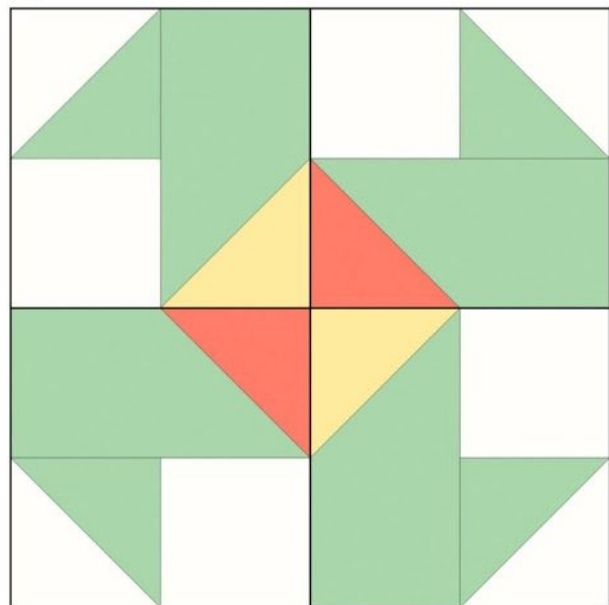
Arrange a white/green HST, a white 1½" square, and a green/yellow Corner Flip unit as shown below. Sew the HST and white square together and press. Then sew the green/yellow Corner Flip unit to the side of the pair.



Quarter Section unit measures 3½" x 3½" unfinished. Make 2. Repeat with a white/green HST, a white 1½" square, and a green/coral Corner Flip unit as shown above. Make 2.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.
