

Winter Tree-Land

The winter holidays are fast approaching and might you need a gift? Better yet, a homemade gift! Grab 2 “jelly roll” strips (any 2 ½” strips) and you are on your way to making a winter wonderland of trees. Big trees, tiny trees and in between trees. This project is meant to be quick and easy. Plus, it doesn’t even need a binding. (Even though I love bindings!) Think Shabby Chic or Country Charm. Whichever your style, you will love this easy project.

Supply List

- ◆ TWO strips cut 2 ½” x WOF (width of fabric)
Dark and light, red and white, red and green, purple and pink, any combination!
- ◆ Paper Templates Diamond and Triangle, will be provided in directions.
If you prefer cutting around an acrylic template Debbie’s **Hex-a-ma-jig Jr.** is the tool to use. You can purchase it on her website at Wendt Quilting, www.wendtquilting.com.
- ◆ Sewing machine, thread, pins, snips, rotary mat, cutter, smaller ruler
(**Hex-a-ma-jig Jr.** optional)



OPTIONS, OPTIONS, OPTIONS

Your Winter Tree Land begins with two strips of fabric. You decide how many and what size trees to make. Options will be given in the cutting directions of the pattern. Options include:

1. 3 Small Trees
2. 1 Small and 1 Large Tree (**FULL KIT Shabby Chic** includes red & white fabric strips/triangle wood pieces/spools/stars *available at www.wendtquilting.com*)
3. A. 1 Medium and 2 Tiny Trees
B. Same as A with color variation
4. 5 Tiny Trees

For Stand-up Trees

Wood - cut into triangles of your chosen tree size and bases (Approximate squares to start with...Large tree 15”, Medium tree 12 ¼”, Small tree 10 ½”, Tiny tree 7½”)

Wall insulation board can also be used but the trees will not be as sturdy/stable.

Large wooden spools or decorative spindles – for tree trunks

Metal stars or snowflakes – for top of trees (can use wooden stars instead)

Pyramid Tree - option 1 uses **in-R-Form** 9” x 20” for three sides and one additional WOF strip for binding. (**in-R-Form** single sided fusible available at [wendtquilting.com](http://www.wendtquilting.com))



Tree Decorations

I chose NOT to decorate my Shabby Chic trees other than the snowflake stars.

For Country Charm – check out **HandBEHG Felts** (handbehg.com) for Felt Balls I used 26 from a 50 Pack of 1 cm Multi Mix and one 2 cm gold Felt Ball on option 2.

For 5 Mug Rugs

Back fabric – 7” x WOF or Fat Quarter

Batting – 7” x 22”
